ATV Thanks Executive Director Glenda Shayne for her dedicated service

The Board of Alternatives to Violence accepted Executive Director Glenda Shayne's resignation, effective December 8, 2017. Shayne, who is pursuing a new opportunity, led the organization through a four-year period of growth and expansion, including the opening of its SafeHouse in October 2016.

"ATV has benefited greatly from Glenda's leadership," says Board President Frederick Richart, "While we are sad to see her go, we wish Glenda all the best in this new phase of her career." Shayne says, "ATV will always hold a special place in my heart; I have given so much of myself to my role here. I feel fortunate to have been an integral part of ATV's growth to this point."

The Board of Directors will begin its search for a new executive director immediately.

Alternatives to Violence is a 501 (c)(3) organization that provides essential supportive services to anyone impacted by violence in Southern Larimer County. Services may include advocacy, information and referrals to local resources, emergency shelter and in some cases longer term housing. They serve victims of domestic violence, people who have witnessed a crime, suicide, or other traumatic events that have negatively affected them.

Mission: ATV, in collaboration with individuals and communities impacted by violence, creates safe pathways away from abusive environments through education, advocacy and shelter. ATV provides services to women, men and children regardless of race, sexual orientation or legal status.
