Alternatives to Violence was established in 1983 and is registered with the Colorado Secretary of State as a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization. Since 1983, Alternatives to Violence has offered victims the opportunity to heal both emotionally and physically in a supportive environment. Each year, we provide emergency shelter, safety planning, advocacy, information and referrals to local resources, crisis intervention, and in some cases longer-term housing to over 800 people.

Mission

Alternatives to Violence provides shelter, advocacy, education and resources for people impacted by domestic violence, sexual assault and human trafficking.

Vision

Alternatives to Violence envisions a safe community free from domestic violence, sexual assault and human trafficking.

- Referrals and resource information
- Community education programs
